### **SAP consulting company itelligence advises missio on the launch of the new intranet portal**

Bielefeld, Germany, May 8, 2007 - missio Internationales katholische Missionswerk e.V. – referred to as "missio" for short, is converting its intranet portal technology to SAP and will be advised and supported in the process by itelligence, a full-service IT provider for SAP.

First, the itelligence consultants will remove the existing intranet portal and will install the new SAP NetWeaver portal. Starting August 13, 2007, a total of around 150 users in Germany will have access to the new portal offering. The internal processes will be especially optimized. The main application area is the central access of applications and data which were previously distributed. The advantage: the uniform interface will be user friendly and each employee will be offered role-based access to his work environment. By means of workflow support, appropriate contact persons will quickly be able to accomplish a task. In addition, the new SAP intranet will administer documents quickly, securely and centrally with the latest Internet technology. The integrated SAP search engine TREX will support accurate searches in vastly different data sources.

The special structure and task of the missionary also required that SAP consultants develop special functions such as event management and an interface to donation management which were implemented with SAP Java and SAP Visual Composer. In addition, various existing external systems including e-mail, time-stamping, and library management software can be accessed via the new portal.

The common processes will be supported by our subsidiary operations in Munich as well as in cooperation with the diocesan locations.”

In order to optimize the project launch time, the introductory project will be hosted by itelligence at the computer center in Bielefeld; in parallel, the portal will be technically extended at the missionary location in Aachen.
