

SAP controls complex commissioning processes in the kitchen industry

Frankfurt, September 24, 2001. Nobilia-Werke J. Stickling GmbH & Co. from Verl, producer of individual kitchens, is investing in a new standard software for better control of the areas of finance accounting and logistics. The company wants to use SAP R/3 for support of its core processes. The IT service provider itelligence AG has been entrusted with the system integration on the basis of its convincing concept for realization.

The integration of finance accounting, purchasing and inventory management for purchased parts and quality management as well as the integration of two warehouse management systems have already been successfully realized. The result is a higher degree of automation in the commissioning of built-in appliances at the time of delivery – a highly sensitive area for the kitchen manufacturer with its average daily loading of 4,000 appliances. The planned use of SAP modules sales and production will in the future provide Nobilia with precise information for each item, allowing the company to give its dealers commission-related information on delivery status.

Nobilial produces in a highly industrialized production environment and conducts extremely complex manufacturing processes in order to produce, commission and deliver 1,100 individually assembled kitchens every day. "Due to the incredible depth and diversity of our product line, the production of our kitchens involves a very large number of different production steps, which must be meaningfully modelled in the SAP system. Consequently, itelligence carried out regular prototyping in cooperation with our various departments, which met with a high degree of acceptance on the part of our employees during the SAP introduction," explain the project manager in charge at Nobilia Dr. Gordon Bartels, head of the IT division and Rüdiger Schliekmann, head of industrial engineering.
